Pastor's Column

Scout Sunday – The Boy Scouts movement began in England on January 24, 1908. British Army officer and war hero, General Robert Baden-Powell, had written training manuals for Military Scouting. After he retired from the Army, he discovered that teachers and youth organizations were using his book. The boys loved the lessons on tracking and observation and organized elaborate games using the book. It had become a best seller. So he re-wrote it for the youth and emphasized



the importance of morality and good deeds. When *Scouting for Boys* was published,

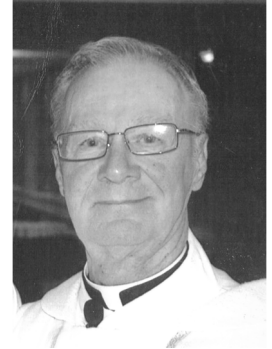
scores of Boy Scout troops sprang up across Britain. It came to the U.S. when Chicago publisher William Boyce was lost in the London fog in 1909. A Boy Scout came to his aid and after guiding Boyce to his destination, the boy refused a tip, explaining that as a Boy Scout he would not accept payment for doing a good deed. This anonymous gesture inspired Boyce to organize the Boy Scouts of America (BSA). Incorporated on February 8, 1910, the movement spread throughout the country. And in 1912, Juliette Gordon Low founded the Girl Scouts of America. So every year, the Sunday before February 8, is observed as Scout Sunday. It's an opportunity for the Scouts to renew their Oath and Law and for us to recognize the contributions of young people and adults to Scouting. Thank you Troop 15 for your service to the parish and community!

Blessing of Throats – St. Blaise was a bishop and a doctor. The first known record of the saint's life comes from the medical writings of Aetius Amideus, where he

is recorded as helping patients suffering from objects stuck in their throat. Because of that, he is the patron saint of those suffering from throat illnesses. As his feast day is on this February 3rd, **we will have a blessing of throats after all our masses this weekend.** He is often depicted in paintings holding 2 crossed candles, so don't be surprised if the priest holds 2 crossed candles and put it over your shoulder as he prays for the intercession of St. Blaise to cure you of every disease, especially of the throat. And don't worry, the candles won't be lit.

AN ONGOING MISSION

In his hometown synagogue, Jesus' neighbors are amazed by his words. Nevertheless, they remind each other, "Is this not Joseph's son?"

Surely the people know who he is. The carpenter's son. The young man who had learned in this very synagogue. The boy down the street.

Conflict arises as Jesus begins to define himself in a new way. When he compares himself to the ancient prophets Elijah and Elisha the tensions grow. The tensions multiply when Jesus begins to tell of a new mission for God's people: the good news of the scriptures is intended for all.

In his famous passage from the First Letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul reminds us of the eternal nature of love. Love does not come to an end. In today's readings, we are reminded that, like love, Jesus' mission cannot be contained. Jesus slips through the crowd of persecutors and moves on to new challenges. We are called to this same perseverance in the name of love.

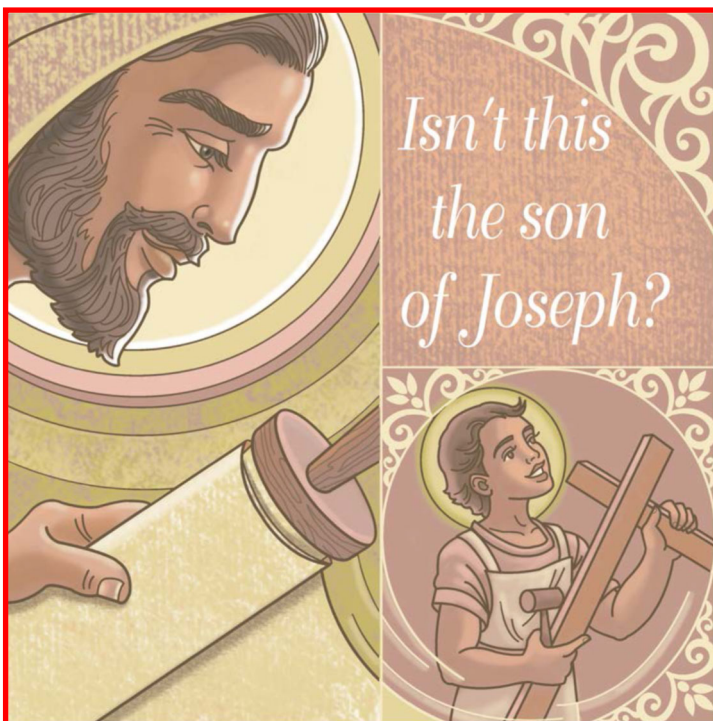
