

SEEING IS BELIEVING

Seeing is believing! Since cellphone screens connect us instantly to social media, live TV, and loved ones' faces near and far, "Doubting Thomas" could be our patron saint: "Unless I see, I will not believe!" But how comforting for any of us who share Thomas's doubt, or love "doubters" who do, to see how kindly Jesus responds. By offering the very evidence that Thomas demanded, Jesus doesn't scold Thomas, but seems to understand such skepticism. Could Jesus have been thinking of us, who long to believe that "Jesus is risen!" but see so much suffering, and perhaps even cause some, that we wonder, how could something so wonderful be true? In today's reading from the Acts of the Apostles, the risen Jesus' healing love comforts through disciples who love others. In Revelation, "our brother John" doesn't just claim he saw Jesus alive, but passes on Jesus' life-giving words, "Do not be afraid." Seeing Jesus in others is believing!

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

An ancient title for this Sunday is *Dominica in Albis*, or "Sunday in White." During the Easter Vigil, the newly baptized are invested with a white garment, a sign that they have put on Christ. At one time, the garments were worn for a full week of celebration and reflection, and on this Sunday the newly baptized would appear in their robes again in their new place among the faithful Eucharist.

In later centuries, the energy of new life at Easter was largely forgotten, and this Sunday was renamed "Quasimodo Sunday," or "Low Sunday." In recent years, with the recovery of the insight that Easter is the privileged time for celebrating and renewing baptism, there is nothing "Low" about this Sunday. At a week's distance, the beauty and grace of our Easter celebration is sustained by joyful alleluias, the blessing and sprinkling of holy water, and the comfort of the Lord's presence to us. He is risen, and he summons us together, opening up the scriptures for us, breaking the bread, filling us with new life.

The Paschal Candle

Last Saturday evening, we celebrated the Feast of all feasts, the Easter Vigil. We gathered in the dark, then processed into the church with the new Paschal Candle whose light was taken from blessed fire. "The Light of Christ" shone brightly in the midst of darkness. This Paschal Candle will remain lit all throughout the masses during this Easter Season. What does this mean?

First, the resurrection of Jesus ushers in a new creation. In the book of Genesis, on the first day, God said, "Let there be light." Jesus, coming as Light, transforms the old creation into a new creation. We who received the Light of Christ, are made new, and receive a new life in Christ.

Second, the renewal of baptismal promise is our commitment to turning away from evil and accepting Jesus into our lives. We accepted the Light of Christ, allowing Him to illuminate our spiritual blindness. However, we have to keep the Light burning in our lives, meaning we have to keep growing in our faith, and this happens by coming to Mass weekly, studying the Word of God, engaging in constant prayer, and participating in our small faith communities.

Finally, the Light of Christ is meant to be shared with others, so that it may shine more brightly. We are all evangelizers. We don't need to go far, just reach out to people in our homes and workplaces, our friends, and be a witness of the Risen Lord, the Light of the World. So next time we see the Paschal Candle beside the altar, remember, it is not just an added decoration, but a central symbol of what Easter is in our Christian lives.



On Monday, May 20th, at 10:30 AM, SAGES will sponsor a Docent Tour of Holy Trinity Russian Orthodox Cathedral, located on 1520 Green Street, by Van Ness Avenue. The Cathedral was founded in 1857 as the episcopal headquarters of the Orthodox Bishop of San Francisco and the West – the oldest Orthodox Community in the US. The present Cathedral was built in 1909 to replace the earlier Church, which was destroyed in the fire of the 1906 earthquake. The present Pastor (Dean) is Fr. Kirill Sokolov. The Cathedral is literally full of symbols of faith – icons, stained glass, and many other architectural elements. More than mere symbols, icons signify and present spiritual realities into which we may enter. As always, **SAGES' Tours are open to all parishioners and friends of St. Anne of the Sunset Church.
