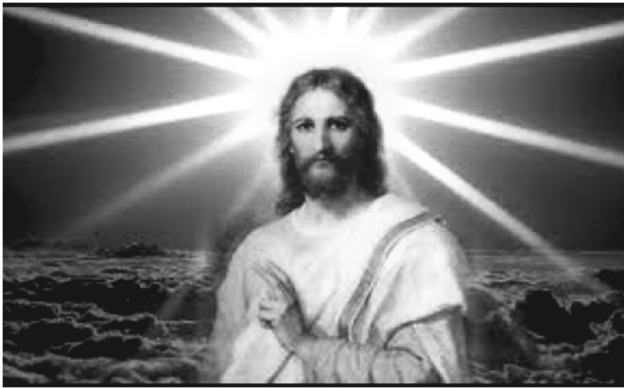

CALLED TO BE HOLY

With this Sunday we begin Ordinary Time. The readings tell us about God's relationship with Israel and John the Baptist's relationship with Jesus. Israel's relationship with God is so close, so intimate, that it is through Israel that God's "salvation [will] reach to the ends of the earth" (*Isaiah 49:6*). But we know from John the Baptist that for Israel to accomplish God's will, it must also recognize that Jesus is the Son of God. During these weeks we also get to know Jesus. We begin to understand more deeply our relationship to Jesus and what that relationship means for us, who are "called to be holy" (*1 Corinthians 1:2*).

FEAST OF FAITH— The Greeting

At several points during the liturgy, the presider greets us with the words, "The Lord be with you." These simple words are not like the greetings that we exchange all day long—our "good mornings," our "hellos" and "how are you." This liturgical greeting has roots deep in the Old Testament. In the book of Ruth, the words "the Lord be with you" are spoken by Boaz to the harvesters who are laboring in his fields (2:4); in the book of Judges, an angel speaks similar words to Gideon (6:12), where they are words of promise: for soon Gideon will lead his oppressed people to victory and freedom. For us, the words become a greeting of peace, a prayer that the Lord will indeed be with us, and a reminder of his promise to be with us always, to the end of the world (*Matthew 28:20*). Our response—"And also with you," soon to be "And with your spirit"—returns to the presider this prayer for the Lord's presence. As we know from the scriptures, a prayer for the Lord's presence is no small thing, for when God comes in our midst, God brings healing, grace, and challenge. God's presence transforms us.

Pastor's Corner

Rite of Welcome – In the Fall, we began the Alpha Course for those interested to learn more about the Christian faith or to complete their Sacraments of Initiation. The way the Church forms adults to be disciples of Christ is similar to how couples prepare for marriage. There are 4 steps:

- In the early stage of a relationship, the couples meet simply to learn more about each other. There are no commitments.
- But if they find that they enjoy each other's company and friendship, they take the next step and become boyfriend and girlfriend.
- Then if they find that they enjoy each other so much that they can't see themselves living without each other, they take the next step and propose marriage.
- The final step, of course, is marriage.

So the **Alpha Course** is the **first step** for the inquirer to get to know who God is. We have five adults who've been journeying with us this past Fall. Now, they're ready to take the **next step** and "go steady" with God. The Church has a ritual for this step called the **Rite of Welcome and Acceptance**. In this step, they are introduced to the community of faith, much like a couple meeting each other's family. In the ritual, they share their name with us and what they are seeking in this journey of faith. We, on our part, promise to pray for them to help them enter into a deeper relationship with God. We make the sign of the cross on their forehead, on their ears, eyes, lips, heart, shoulders, and feet to help them open their heart and mind to God, to help them see and hear the Lord in their lives, and to help them walk with Him. The Ritual is meant to be a warm and welcoming encouragement to these new inquirers seeking to know the Lord more and to enter into a deeper relationship with Him. On our part, we promise to support them with our prayers.

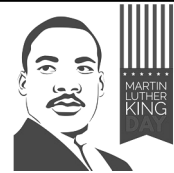
