### ***Music Ministry Still Active & Still Serving.***

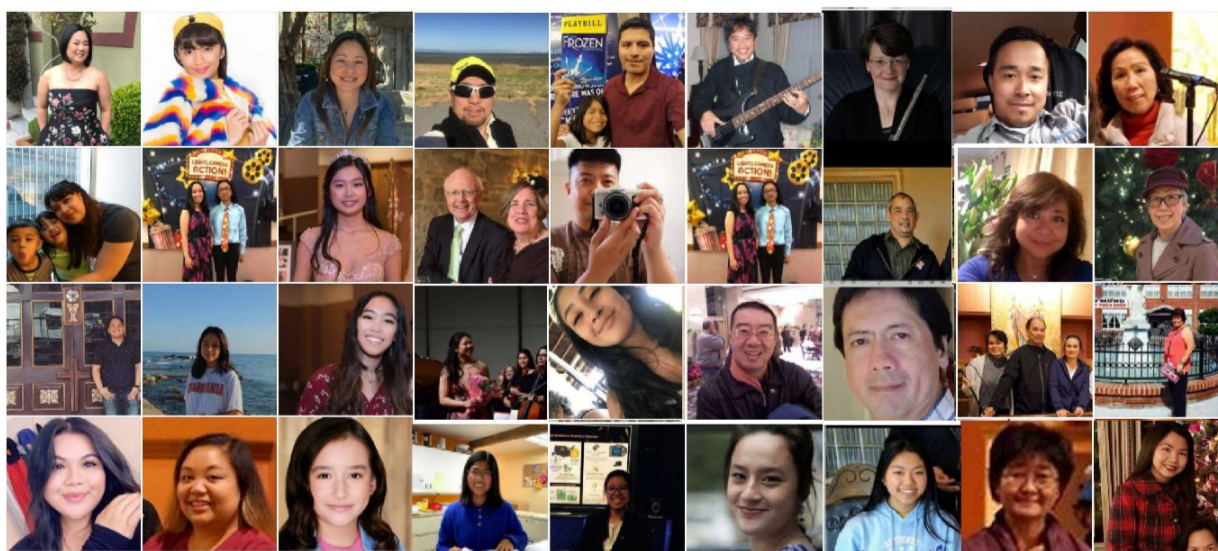
