

Dear Parishioners of Good Saint Anne!

I always look forward to joining you for the Novena to your patroness Good Saint Anne. This year I was especially excited thinking I could take a scenic drive up the coast to be with you. Unfortunately, like so many things this year we have had to modify our plans.

This year we will have a virtual novena. With the continued high infection rate and the limit on numbers your Pastor Fr. Dan has decided it is best that the novena be held on line. The priests in the parish will celebrate the Novena mass at 8:45am and the Redemptorists will celebrate the novena at 3:00pm. The novena will be posted on line so you will be able to participate at any time. I have invited 8 Redemptorists to join me for the nine days of the novena: familiar faces including Frs. John Schmidt; Ted Lawson, Lamar Partin, Eugene Butumbacal, Maurice Nutt and Aaron Meszaros and some new faces Frs. Ted Dorcey and Kevin Zubel.
