## Pastor's Corner

**Staying Strong in the Faith** – Pope Francis at the beginning of the pandemic, published a free book entitled, “Strong in the Face of Tribulation.” He reminds us that what will see us through this pandemic is by staying together in common faith, like the apostles and Mother Mary after Jesus’ crucifixion and death. Though they didn’t understand what was happening, how Jesus who was clearly God’s anointed was so cruelly executed and taken from them, yet they stayed together and prayed together. Thomas, who was away, missed out when the Risen Lord appeared to them. They, who were together, had their faith renewed and strengthened.

So Pope Francis reminds us to stay together in adversity even when we are faced with doubt and filled with questions. We should remain close to the Church of Jesus, pray together, so that our own faith might be strengthened and we may then bring faith and hope to others. The book has 3 sections, the first is composed of prayers to help us pray together, the 2nd contains guides in how to still receive God’s graces and indulgences when we are sheltering-in-place, and the last section, contains Pope Francis’ reflection in the midst of this pandemic. This year as we celebrate our 113th St. Anne Novena, the theme we have chosen is this book by Pope Francis, Strong in the Face of Tribulation.

The Novena will begin on Sat, July 18 and conclude on Sunday, July 26, the Feast day of St. Anne. You are welcome to join us:

- at 8:45am (Mon-Sat), 10am (Sun) with the priests of St. Anne for Novena Masses
  - and at 3pm each day, with the Redemptorist Fathers for the Novena devotion prayers and reflection.
- Since the Redemptorists are not able to travel out here to be with us and will only be livestreaming at 3pm each day on our Facebook page, yet they have lined up great speakers from throughout the nation. You’ll be able to see again **Frs. Patrick Keyes, John Schmidt, Ted Lawson, Lamar Partin, Eugene Butumbacal, Maurice Nutt, Aaron Meszaros and some new faces Frs. Ted Dorcey and Kevin Zobel.**

Clearly this was not the way we had wanted to conduct the 113th Novena, but I’m grateful for the cooperation of everyone to make the best out of this pandemic. 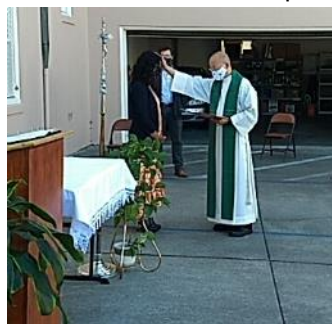
