Feast of the Assumption, Aug 15, celebrates when the Virgin Mary having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed by God, body and soul into heavenly glory.

On the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Pope Francis said that Mary's assumption into Heaven was an infinitely greater achievement than man's first steps on the moon. "When man set foot on the moon, he said a phrase that became famous: 'That's one small step for man, one giant leap for mankind.' In essence, humanity had reached a historic milestone. But today, in Mary's Assumption into Heaven, we celebrate an infinitely greater achievement.

"Our Lady set foot in Heaven." The life of the Virgin Mary is an example of how "the Lord works wonders with the little ones," Pope Francis said. God works through "those who do not believe themselves great but who give great space to God in life. He enlarges His mercy in those who trust in Him, and raises up the humble. Mary praises God for this," he said. The Virgin Mary's witness is a reminder to praise God each day, as the Mother of God did. "Let us ask Our Lady, the Gate of Heaven, for the grace to begin each day by raising our gaze to Heaven, to God, to say to Him: 'Thank you!"
