THE MEANING OF DISCIPLESHIP

The geography of today's Gospel is significant. Jesus is completing his ministry in Galilee and beginning his journey to Jerusalem, where he will meet both death and resurrection. The prediction of his death placed here is the second of three in Mark's Gospel, and as usual it is the occasion for an important teaching on the part of Jesus. Today that lesson is tied to the need for his disciples to embrace a ministry of service. A play on words in Aramaic would have linked the words "child" and "servant," thus turning Jesus' gesture of placing a child in their midst into an illustration of his understanding of himself as the Servant of the Lord. It is that same awareness of the meaning of their ministry that Jesus (and Mark) wishes to instill in the disciples. Theirs must be a ministry of service if they are to follow in the footsteps of Jesus. And that service might even require of them that they be "handed over" to death. What would have been—in the culture of Jesus' day—an ordinary discussion of social status ("who is the greatest") becomes in Mark's context a key insight into the meaning of discipleship for the disciples and for us.

Missionaries of Jesus – Next weekend, Sep 25-26, **Fr. Aris Villanueva** will be coming to share with us the Missionary work they do. The Missionary of Jesus is a somewhat recent community founded on June 12, 2002 in the Philippines by 41 seasoned missionaries. They've worked in places as diverse as Belgium, Cameroon, Congo, Dominican Republic, Guatemala, Haiti, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Mexico, Mozambique, Nigeria, Philippines, Senegal, Taiwan, United States and Zambia. It was because of the "changing landscape of mission," that prompted them to change their approach to mission and form this new community. Today:

- ◆ They minister to the marginalized poor in Navotas, Diocese of Kallokan and Sto. Nino, San Mateo, Rizal and in Marahan, Diocese of Davao in the Philippines.
- ◆ They journey with migrants in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and in the Diocese of Brownsville, USA.
- ◆ They accompany the indigenous people; give expression to their Christian faith through their culture and tradition.
- ◆ And they dream of fostering a fraternal world with our sisters and brothers of other religions and beliefs in the Prelature in Marawi and in Vietnam.

We look forward to hearing from the experiences of **Fr. Villanueva** and the work he and his brothers do. I encourage your support for their missionary work done in our own country and around the world.

FEAST of FAITH: Doxology and Amen

"Doxology" comes from a Greek word meaning "words of praise." The Eucharistic Prayer ends with a doxology addressed to the triune God: "Through him, and with him, and in him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever." It is an exclamation of praise, honor, and glory to God, reminding us that we receive everything from God through the Son, in the power of the Spirit. At the consecration, the priest held up the host and then the chalice for us to see and adore. During the doxology, the host and chalice are held up again, but this time they are held up and offered to God the Father. With the doxology, the Eucharistic Prayer ends, as it began, with words of praise addressed to the Father: truly, it is right and just to give God praise, and we assent to this in our whole-hearted acclamation, "Amen." Never was more meaning packed into so short a word. This "Amen," sometimes and fittingly called "the great Amen," is our response to the entire Eucharistic Prayer.

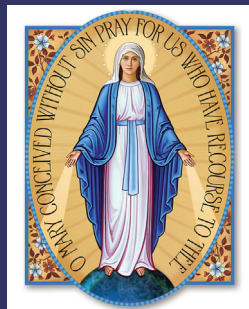
