WORLD MISSION SUNDAY.

World Mission Sunday is a day set aside by the Catholic Church throughout the world to publicly renew its commitment to the missionary movement. It was created by **Pope Pius XI** in 1926 as the day of prayer for the missions and support for the mission. The first worldwide mission Sunday collection took place in 1927. World mission Sunday is celebrated in all the local churches as the feast of catholicity and universal solidarity, so Christians the world over will recognize their common responsibility with regards to the evangelization of the world.

The Liturgy for today looks at how we can live in the faith and know joy by belonging to our savior, the Son of God. The Old Testament reading speaks of the happiness of God's people who had been exiled and separated from Him, but whom He draws back to Himself. "Shout with joy, ...proclaim your praise and say. The Lord has delivered His people. I will gather them from the ends of the World, with the blind and the lame in their midst, the mothers and those with child; they shall return as an immense throng. They departed in tears, but I will console them and guide them" (*Jeremiah 31:7-9*). In Jesus we find the New Covenant, and, through the gift of faith, we claim Him for our own. In Christ is the supreme blessing of eternal life. We are called to offer this gift to others through prayer, witness, and example.

On this World Mission Sunday, we acknowledge our part in sharing our Catholic faith and in supporting the work of missionaries- priests and consecrated lay men and women. They serve our brothers and sisters in many lands who need nourishment for both soul and body. **Pope Francis** chose as the theme for this World Mission, "**We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard**" (*Acts 4:20*) He wrote in his message for the celebration, "**We recall with gratitude all those men and women who by their testimony of life help us to renew our baptismal commitment to be generous and joyful apostles of the**

According to our **Archbishop Salvatore**. "Last year we were unable to support missionaries due to the pandemic and assembly. Any financial support by which your means allows you to support those in most need will be greatly appreciated. As we rebuild our lives help us to also reach out in solidarity and support for the Mission Church, and the work and witness of missionaries in the Pope's missions."

FEAST of FAITH: The Sound of Communion

The priest receives Holy Communion, and then there is movement, a bustle of activity, as we prepare to join the Communion procession. This holy meal does not happen in silence! Instead, we sing together even as we rise and move forward in procession to the altar. We must change and move to receive the Eucharist, and fittingly so, since the Eucharist is transformative—it demands action of us, internal as well as external. We do not receive the sacrament in silence, but with a dialogue that is also a profession of faith: "The Body of Christ." "Amen." "The Blood of Christ." "Amen." We acknowledge the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist with our "Amen" of faith, but more, our "Amen" is also a prayer that we may become what we receive, the Body of Christ, living and active in the world. We receive him not that he may become a part of us, but that we may become a part of him—part, too, of all the others who receive him, the whole communion of believers.
