Welcome to our New Music Director— Please join me in welcoming our new Music Director, **Mr. Randell Rentar**. He comes to us from the Diocese of Monterey, having moved up here recently. He has over 15 years of experience in Catholic music ministry, having served at various parishes as an accompanist and choir director. And while in Medical School at the prestigious University of Santo Tomas in Manila, Philippines, he was the Choir Conductor and Accompanist for their Medicine Glee Club. The choir, consisting of 25 student doctors, would perform regularly at collegiate choral competitions as well as at special masses throughout the academic year. Although he has a Biology and a Medical degree, he found his true passion in music and the leading of choirs and congregations in singing and praising the Lord. At the Sunday 8am mass that has been traditionally a “silent” mass with no music, he gently introduced quiet meditative music to help raise our minds and hearts to God. Afterwards, I pulled out my violin and Rachel Leluc joined in and we made beautiful music together. He easily transposed to a lower pitch to accommodate Rachel, and I found him to be a natural choir leader. If you enjoy singing or playing an instrument and even if you’re just an amateur like me, don’t hesitate to join in. Give it a try during Lent or Easter and I’m sure you’ll have fun with Randell leading. Welcome aboard, Randell! We’re glad you’re here with us!!!




The Third Sunday of Lent

Paluch Company, has suspended print operations at a number of parishes, including ours, as a cost-saving strategy. They formerly printed our bulletins for free but depended on the revenue they received from the ads on the back page to sustain their operations. But with the Covid lockdown, many of their advertisers have gone out of business. In addition, many have stopped hard-copy ads and switched exclusively to online advertising. So going forward, they will only send Saint Anne's its 4-page full-color bulletin electronically.
