**Pastor's Column**

**Promises from the Sacred Heart of Jesus** – Last Friday, June 24, was the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. While Divine Mercy celebrates the Triune God's infinite mercy, this feast celebrates Jesus' love for all human-kind. On Dec 27, 1673, Sr. Margaret Alacoque experienced a private revelation. Our Lord appeared to her and invited her to rest a long time on His Divine breast. Jesus continued to appear to her for the next 18 months,



revealing the marvels of His love for human kind. In Sr. Margaret's frequent visions of the Sacred Heart, she said that His Divine Heart was "more radiant than the sun. It is as transparent as crystal with its adorable wound visible and it appears as a 'furnace' of burning flames." In 1675, during the feast of Corpus Christi, the Lord spoke



to her, revealing that "here is the heart that has so loved men as to spare nothing... to prove its love for them; and in return, I receive from most of them, only ingratitude." So Jesus asked her to have a special feast established in honor of His Sacred Heart on the Friday after the feast of Corpus Christi. Jesus asked His followers to receive Holy Communion on that day, and to make atonement for the sins of the world by an act of reparation. And so, little by little, the feast of the Sacred Heart spread throughout the Church. Jesus revealed to St Margaret 12 promises to those souls who would honor the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus:

1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their homes.
3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
4. I will be their secure refuge during life and above all in death.
5. I will bestow a large blessing upon all their undertakings.
6. Sinners shall find in My Heart the source and the infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Tepid souls shall grow fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
9. I will bless every place where a picture of My Heart shall be set up and honored.
10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart, never to be blotted out.
12. I promise you, in the excessive mercy of My Heart, that My all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate on the first Friday in nine consecutive months, the grace of final perseverance; They shall not die in My disgrace nor without receiving their Sacraments; My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

Although the feast was last Friday, it's never too late to recommit ourselves to His Most Sacred Heart that overflows with love for each one of us.

**DISCIPLESHIP'S COSTS**

In today's first reading, God tells the prophet Elijah to prepare Elisha to succeed him. Succeeding Elijah will be no easy task; he has spent his life facing threats from the kings he has confronted about their infidelity to the God of Israel. The psalm illustrates the emotional and spiritual distress that the prophets' steadfast faithfulness to God brought them. Paul's description of the Christian's freedom from the law as opposed to "the desire of the flesh" puts this struggle at the very heart of Christian identity. The reading from Luke's Gospel recounts Jesus' decision to journey toward Jerusalem, where he knows he will meet his earthly fate. Following Jesus—like succeeding Elijah as prophet—will now become more difficult. Unlike his calls to the first disciples, Jesus encounters those who are not ready or are not strong enough to journey with him
