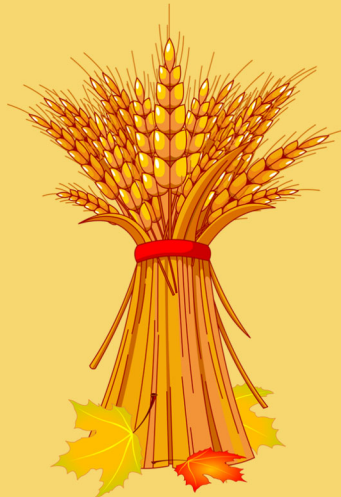

**Hurricane Ian Relief** – This Sunday, our 2<sup>nd</sup> collection will go to Catholic Charities USA (CCUSA) which is helping those affected by Hurricane Ian. Although each Diocese in the US has its own Catholic Charities to assist the poor, in 1990 the US Conference of Catholic Bishops commissioned CCUSA to respond to disasters in the US. Relief and recovery services are provided by the local Catholic Charities of the Diocese; however, CCUSA supports these local Charities by coordinating the efforts of Catholics from throughout the nation. Hurricane Ian has been described as one of the strongest hurricanes ever to hit the US, so our collective response to this great need will be greatly appreciated. Our collective effort makes CC the largest US social-safety-net provider outside of the Federal Government. - Priests and religious brothers and sisters buy food and the bare essentials that make it possible to

proclaim the Gospels and celebrate the Sacraments.

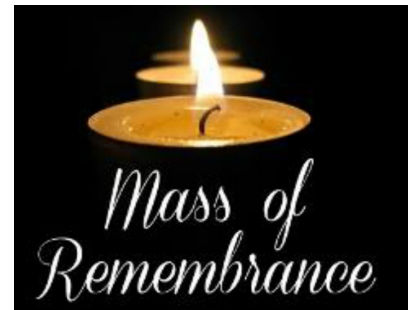
- Build schools and orphanages that care for children in places few people visit.
- Provide for the formation of our seminarians and religious men and women.

I remember years ago bringing a group of high school students to Tijuana on a mission trip to help build homes. After the project was completed, the family that was a beneficiary of our efforts shared that they were deeply touched that people in the US cared for them. So our collective effort will help show that the brothers and sisters of Christ at St Anne Church in San Francisco are willing to assist strangers in need on the other side of the country through our love for them and our love for the Lord we serve.

*Persistence*

Exodus recounts the journey of the Israelites out of slavery in Egypt to the land promised to their ancestors. It was not an easy journey. In today's reading, they are attacked by Amalek and his soldiers, members of one of the peoples who live in the land through which the Israelites are traveling. Moses was on the hilltop with his arms raised to invoke the LORD's assistance in the battle below, a powerful illustration of the LORD's favor upon Israel. If the soldiers were to lift up their eyes to that hill (*see Psalm 121:1*), they would be reassured by Moses's presence and posture. Paul urges the Thessalonians to persist in proclaiming the gospel, and Jesus likewise commends the widow for her persistence in pursuit of the justice due her.
