Pastor's Column

What Do You Wish for Your Relationship? – When I was a know-it-all teen, I remember asking my dad a similar question and his response surprised me. He simply said *Peace*. Looking back now, I can understand. There were conflicts at home, a large part of them I'm sure from that know-it-all teen. But thanks to some outside help that enabled us to see and understand each other better, our relationships were enriched and did improve. At the last Priests' Convocation at the end of September, **Communio** was introduced to the Priests of our Archdiocese. **Communio** is a Full-Circle Relationship Ministry that helps Churches provide vision, community and skills to individuals at each stage of a relationship. This includes singles, couples preparing for marriage, those already married, and couples struggling in their marriage. After discussion with the Parish Council and approval from the Finance Council, we decided to give this ministry a try for a year. As one priest in Florida who welcomes this ministry into his parish shared, the reason he does it is because it helps save marriages. So I wanted to share this information with you now, about something that we're kicking off later this year. Seeking Your Feedback – The Parish Council and I are looking at how we may best serve you— from what ministries may best cater to your needs or interests to what mass times you prefer. We'd love to hear from you to get a sense of what we're doing well and how we can improve. To help us do that, we have designed a 2-part survey, one for this week and another one for next week. Why have 2 surveys and not just one? The 1st one for this week (2/12) is a general survey for the direction of our parish. It's to help us plan for our future. The 2nd survey done next week (2/19) is a little more focused regarding **Communio's** Relational Ministry. As I shared earlier, we are kicking off **Communio** this year. To do that, they have a 90-second survey to help them know our community and how to best serve us. So I'd appreciate it if you could help us with both of the anonymous surveys. The Glory of the Divine Way

Today's readings draw us into ageless, vibrant depths. Followers of God's law, we belong to ancient traditions. Children of God, we marvel at the freshness of creation. The Old Testament readings, from Sirach and the Psalms, celebrate the rich blessings we receive when we observe God's commands—not because we are slaves to the law, but because the law gives life in abundance. Saint Paul's Letter to the Corinthians confirms the glory of divine law, but warns that God's ways tend to be unpopular and misunderstood in this world. Paul speaks of the ancient wisdom of God, which is mysteriously both "hidden" and "revealed." God does not have secret codes that we earthly mortals cannot understand; in love, God reveals the glory of the divine way in Jesus. Saint Matthew's Gospel emphasizes the importance of living in God's law, enlivened by a deep and personal relationship with Jesus.
