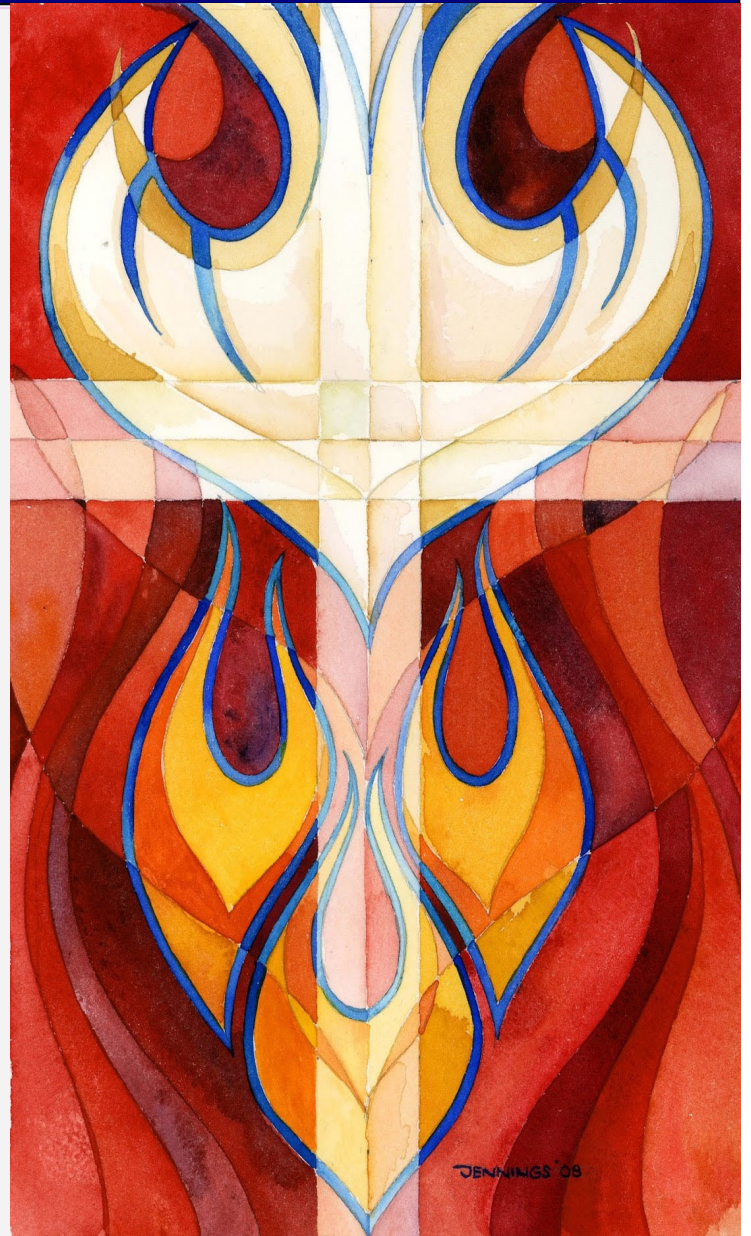

Retirement of Mrs. Barbara Creedon – On Tuesday, May 23, 2023 @ 11am, the School celebrated a retirement Mass with Mrs. Creedon. She has been at St Anne for 23 years and has been in education for 48 years. Ever since she was in 4th grade, she knew she wanted to be a teacher. Happy Anniversary Fr. Peter Zhai - Ordained on May 27, 2006, Fr. Peter is celebrating his 17th year of priesthood this weekend. Born in China into a Catholic family, he grew in his faith, which in spite of government restrictions on the Church was nurtured through his parents' deep love for the Lord. In 1994 he entered the Society of the Divine Word (SVD) and completed his theological studies at the Catholic Theological Union in Chicago in 2006. His 1st assignment was at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton in Los Angeles, and in 2011 he served at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in Redwood City. Not too long afterwards, he became and continues to be the Director of Chinese Ministries for the Archdiocese of San Francisco while in residence at St. Anne. He is also the local Superior of his religious community. He is well loved, not only by the Chinese community in this parish, but throughout the Bay Area and beyond. 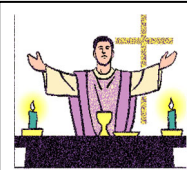
