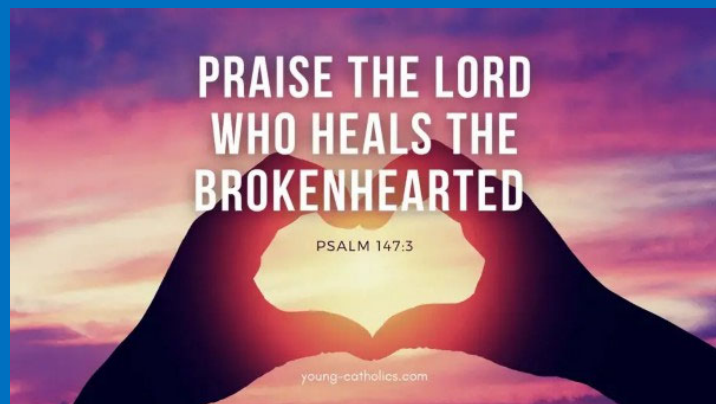

Restoration

The theme of restoration is central to Jesus' ministry, as showcased in the readings for the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B. The physical healings Jesus performs are outward signs of a deeper spiritual restoration. In a world marred by sin and brokenness, Jesus' actions symbolize the dawn of a new kingdom where oppression, illness, and death are overcome by life, wholeness, and hope.

This concept of restoration is not confined to Jesus' time but extends to our present reality. As followers of Christ, we are called to participate in this restorative mission. Like the disciples, we are invited to witness Jesus' life and teachings and to carry the message of hope and healing to the world. St. Paul's teachings in the second reading for the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year B echo this call, urging us to be agents of God's renewing power in our communities and beyond. Our role in God's restorative plan involves not just sharing the Good News but also embodying it through acts of love, mercy, and compassion. By doing so, we participate in the ongoing work of Christ, bringing light to places of darkness and offering hope where there is despair.

Pastor's Column

What's A Marriage Course? – The Marriage Course is a series of 7 sessions designed to help couples invest in their relationship and build a strong marriage. Just as we would never dream of buying a new sports car and never giving it any periodic maintenance, so our relationship with the most significant person in our lives can use ongoing maintenance to keep it healthy and strong. So what does a Marriage Course look like? Each session begins with couples eating together. This gives guests a chance to unwind and connect before the session's episode. It also helps to create the atmosphere of a date. Then a video is played where the episodes are around 45 minutes in length, with breaks for conversations. Each episode explores a different topic through real experiences, expert insights, and relevant teaching. The topics covered are: 1) Strengthening Connection; 2) The Art of Communication; 3) Resolving Conflict; 4) The Power of Forgiveness; 5) The Impact of Family; 6) Good Sex; & 7) Love in Action. Although other couples will be taking the Course together, the conversation between each couple remains private. The Course simply provides a space for each couple to have intimate conversations and helps them engage openly and honestly throughout the session. So what do you think? **Take your spouse on a date, join other couples for a nice evening with free food and child care, and strengthen your love for each other.** When: **Thursday, Feb 8, 2024 from 7-9pm** (every other week for 7 weeks). Where: **St Anne School Library**. Cost: Free Course, Free Food, Free Wine & Free Childcare.

We're fortunate he accepted our invitation to be our **Lenten Retreat Speaker** around these topics. Based on his availability, our **Lenten Retreat** will be early this year, on the Saturday right after Ash Wednesday, which will be **Sat, Feb 17 from 10am – 2pm** in the **School Cafeteria**. At the retreat, we'll not only hear his presentations, but we'll also have time to discuss their relevance in our lives and then to come before the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration. So join us to see the Lord continue to work His miracles in our modern world and to help people come to faith and trust in our Heavenly Father.
