Father's Column

St Anne Novena - What's a novena and why pray a novena? The word *novena* comes from Latin and it means *nine*. It is used to refer to 9 days of prayer. The first novena, 9 days of prayer, happened at the Ascension, when Jesus instructed His disciples to pray for the coming of the Holy Spirit. Nine days later, the Holy Spirit came upon the Disciples at Pentecost. In some cultures, after the death of a loved one, family members and friends also gather to pray the rosary for their beloved for 9 days. This is a double blessing not only for the deceased who receives these prayers to accompany them to heaven, but also for those who mourn, that they will not mourn alone. Typically family members and friends gather in the evening after work, and they pray and eat a meal together. This is a beautiful way to show mutual support during a time of loss. Another reason to pray a novena is because Jesus taught us to persevere in prayer and not to give up. Whatever your need is, you can bring it to the grandmother of Jesus and ask for her intercession. Many people have shared their prayers being answered at a St Anne Novena, from finding a good husband, to a miraculous birth, to family members coming to faith and even healing. So if there's something you're worried about, turn it over to God in prayer and you can ask the grandmother of Jesus to pray with you and for your intention. The Novena of St Anne begins on Thursday, July 18 and concludes on her feast day on Friday, July 26. The theme this year is *The Eucharist*.
