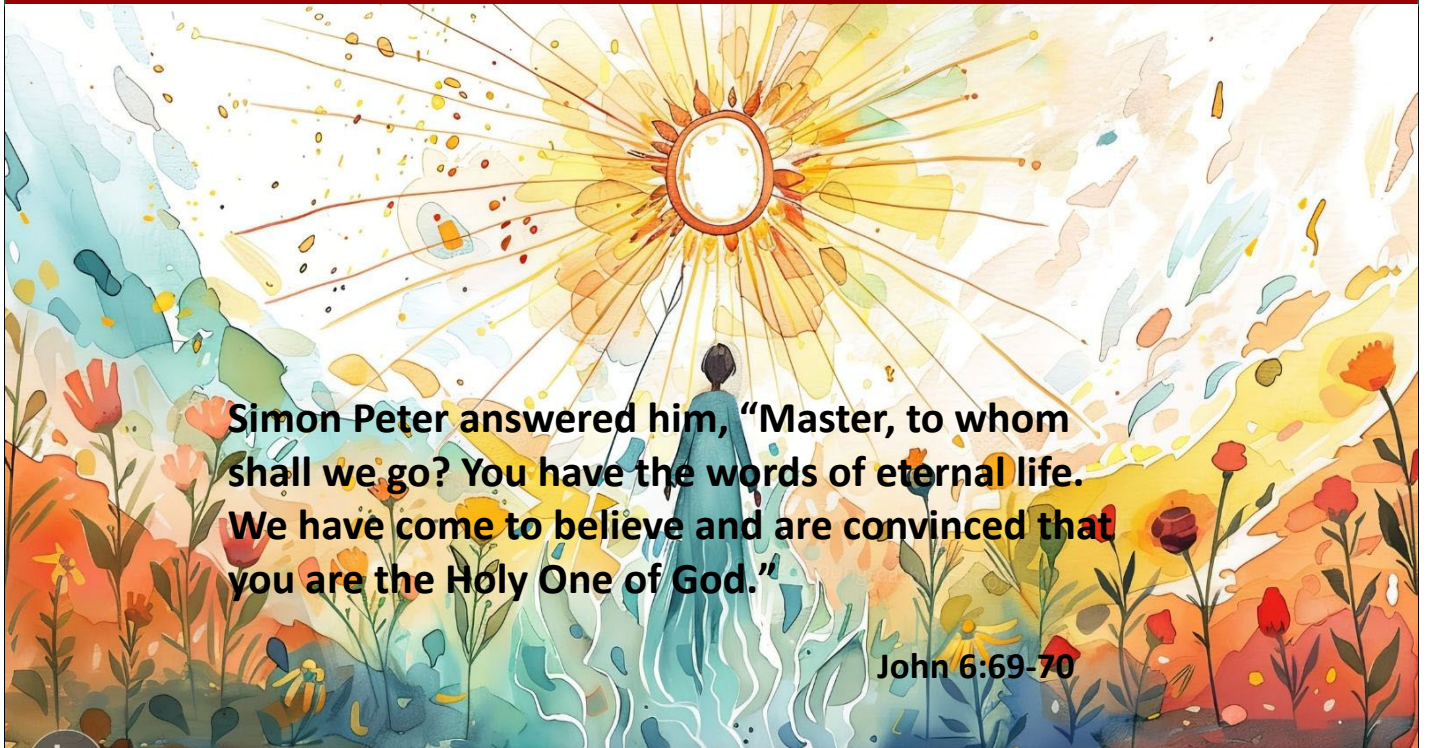

Back to School – Another school year has begun as we welcomed back our students and their parents to our elementary school on Tuesday, August 20, 2024. With the retirement in June of Mr. Thomas White, our former vice-principal, Ms. Mify Lam, stepped up to be the new Principal and gave everyone a warm welcome as we kicked off a new school year.

*Although Sunday School won't begin until Sunday, September 8, but registration has begun. You can sign up after the Sunday masses in the vestibule, or contact our Religious Education Coordinator, Ms. Carmen Perlas, for information or registration. You can reach her via email at cperlas@stanne-sf.org, or by calling the rectory at 415-665-1600. Sunday School offers to public school students education about their faith and to help them prepare for the sacraments that include Baptism, Holy Communion and Confirmation. Class time are from 11:15am to 12:30pm at the School, and families are encouraged to attend mass together beforehand at 10am on Sundays. With the retirement of Mr. Ken DelPonte, Ms. Perlas will also be our teacher for **adults interested to learn more about the Catholic faith**, or to complete their Sacraments of Initiation. If you know anyone interested, or if you are interested yourself, please feel free to reach out to her for information and registration.*

Next, are you interested to learn Mandarin, Chinese? It is being offered to both children and adults. St Anne students can take it as an after school subject, 3 days a week, on Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 3:30-4:30pm beginning on September 3. Or it is also offered on Saturdays from 9am-12pm beginning on September 7. Saturday classes are popular with Public School students. This year, Ms. Eva Wong, the Director of the Chinese School, is offering this language school to adults on Saturdays, from 2pm – 5pm. If you've been curious about the Chinese language and want to know how to read Chinese characters, this will be a fun program to keep your mind active and ward off dementia.
