Pastor's Column

The NeoCatechumenal Way – NCW is a prayer community in the Catholic Church and there is one present here in our parish. In the early Church, adults interested to learn about the faith and wanted to be baptized, were first enrolled into a stage called the catechumenate. Drawing from this model, this New (or Neo) Catechumenate, seeks to help adults deepen their faith, or come to know the faith. It has been approved by the Holy See as a “Post baptismal catechumenate (education) at the service of the Bishops as a form of diocesan implementation of Christian Initiation and of ongoing education in faith, in accordance with the indications of the 2nd Vatican Council and the Magisterium of the Church.” The 3 fundamental elements of the Neocatechumenate, their tripod, are Liturgy, Scripture and Community. They seek to understand scripture better, celebrate the Liturgy with great faith and do it all in the context of a faith community. For the next 8 weeks, from September 9 until November 3, you’re invited to journey with them and to go deeper in faith.
