**New Batch of Servers Being Trained** – Each year around this time of the year, in preparation for our 8<sup>th</sup> graders who will be heading off to High School, we have a training for students who'd like to Altar Serve. 3 or 4 of the 8<sup>th</sup> grade Altar Servers, helped me train the future servers. This year, we have not only 13 5<sup>th</sup> graders interested, but 6 6<sup>th</sup> and 4 7<sup>th</sup> graders who signed up for Altar Serving. This is an unusually high number as these 23 will be an addition to the 11 in 7<sup>th</sup> grade who are currently serving. So we'll be blessed with 34 total servers beginning in the Summer. In our elementary school, Junior High students are required to do service hours, however, serving God at the Altar does not count toward these service hours. The reason is because we're trying to teach them that sometimes, we should offer service to God without expecting something in return. We do, however, near the end of the school year, offer them a Picnic during the school day and mention their service in their High School recommendation.
