We Now Have a Doctor in the Family - Fr. Peter Zhai in early May, successfully defended his doctoral thesis on Evangelization and graduated with a degree in Doctor of Ministry in Spirituality (D.Min.) from the Catholic University of America (CUA). For the past 3+ years, he has been working on this degree while continuing his work full time as the Director of Chinese Ministry in the Archdiocese of San Francisco. In the summer, he would go to CUA for classes and during the rest of the year, he would take his classes on-line. His father, brother and sister-in-law traveled here from China to attend his graduation on March 17, 2025. He then took them to visit the East Coast, and stopped off this weekend on the West Coast. Here, with the Chinese Catholic community in San Francisco and San Mateo Counties, we celebrated his accomplishment. On Memorial Day, after praying for our fallen heroes, we proceeded with a lunch celebration for him at the Chinese Center. Besides his family, his brothers from his Society of Divine Word community, Fr. Ray Reyes, former Pastor of St. Anne, and retired Bishop Daniel Walsh, former resident at St Anne, were also in attendance.



The Chinese center was packed and as people gathered to socialize and take pictures with our proud “son,” food was also being prepared out in the Convent garden with 2 lambs being grilled. Along with a roast pig, fried rice, noodles, plenty of vegetables and egg rolls, it was a feast fit for a king. Congratulations Fr. Peter!
