Until We Meet Again – As some of you may already know, a former Pastor of St. Anne, Fr. Tony McGuire, passed away peacefully on May 11, 2025 at the age of 85. In 1995, when I was a seminarian and doing my Pastoral Year here, a year of internship living and working in a parish, he was the Pastor that supervised and mentored me. He was a wonderful model of a good shepherd as he made time to visit the homebound, the school and be present to the different activities going on in the parish. In spite of his advance arthritis that deformed his fingers, he never complained but was always a person of good cheer. This July 5th would have been his 60th year of priesthood. He was ordained in 1965, served at Most Holy Trinity and St. Patrick's down in San Jose, when it was still part of the San Francisco Archdiocese, and then later at St. Monica, St. Gregory, Most Holy Redeemer, St. Anne and he retired after serving at St. Matthew's in 2015. He learned Spanish to serve as Chaplain to the Spanish speaking community, and later when he saw the need, he learned Cantonese to serve the Chinese community here at St. Anne. It was he who inspired and encouraged me to go to Hong Kong to learn Cantonese to serve the Chinese community here. Before his last assignment at St. Matthew's, he also served as Secretary of Ethnic and Cultural Affairs in the US Conference of Catholic Bishops in Washington D.C. He was a well-respected priest and he continued to serve the Hispanics even after his retirement. The schedule for Fr. McGuire's funeral at St. Matthew's in San Mateo is as follows:
