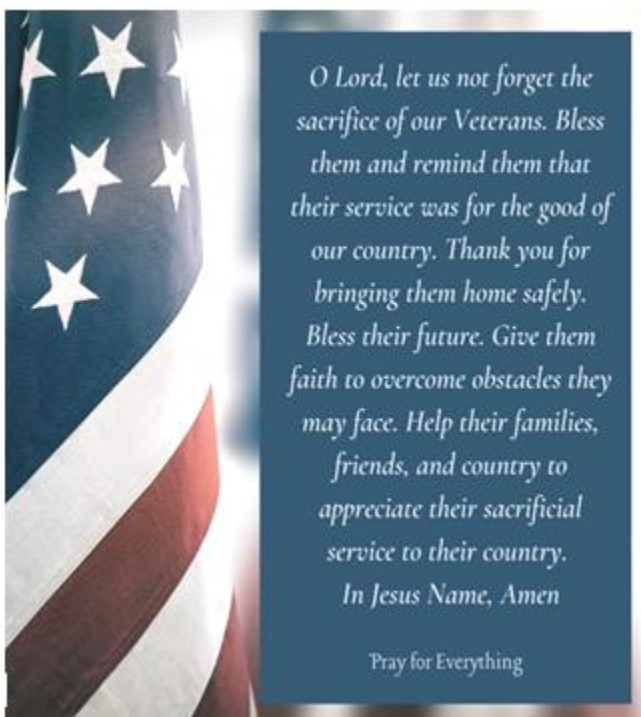

Pastor's Column

Honoring Our Veterans – In Chris Kyle's autobiography entitled "American Sniper," published in 2012 and made into a movie in 2014, he tells his story as a Navy SEAL who served 4 tours in Iraq from 1999 to 2009. His story reminds us of the courage of our military men and women, the bond that they have and their willingness to sacrifice for one another. It also reminds us of the toll of war and the sacrifices that our military members make. Not only is there a physical cost with the potential of losing one's life, one's friend, or one's limb, but there is an emotional cost as well. His story does not sugar coat the cost to family life, how his military service and losses affected his relationship with his wife and family after returning home. But just as he saw himself as a shepherd, using his sniper skills to protect his fellow soldiers, so after returning home, he also encouraged fellow veterans to come together to share their stories, as a way to help them deal with their Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD). This week as we honor our veterans, let's hold them in prayer for the sacrifices and the crosses that they may still bear. And let us thank them for their selfless sacrifice for us and our nation.
