Morning Prayer



Prayer to Good St. Anne

O Good St. Anne, you welcome, listen and guide pilgrims, so I humbly present myself to you. Help me by your prayers to remain united with your grandson Jesus. Pray for me so I keep the fire of the Holy Spirit alive in my heart. I want to let the Spirit be active in my life to give me strength to choose Jesus and pray for those around me. I trust in your care, St. Anne; bring my prayers to Jesus so I can rejoice and be glad in His love. Amen.

The Chaplet of St. Anne

1. In honor of Jesus, we pray for doctors, researchers, test patients and all who care for the sick.
 - a. **1 Our Father** - Our Father, who art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy Name; Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread, and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.
 - b. **5 Hail Mary's** - Hail Mary, full of grace; the Lord is with thee; blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.
 - c. **1 Glory Be** - Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.
 - d. Conclude with: St. Anne, pray for us!
2. In honor of Mary, we pray for the health and well-being of all, especially those who do "essential" services for us (i.e. – grocery clerks & bus drivers).
 - a. 1 Our Father, 5 Hail Mary's & 1 Glory Be
 - b. St. Anne, pray for us!
3. In honor of St. Anne, we pray for those who have died and those who mourn their passing.
 - a. 1 Our Father, 5 Hail Mary's & 1 Glory Be
 - b. St. Anne, pray for us!

Prayer for the Sick:

Good St. Anne, your grandson Jesus accepted suffering to share with us the virtue of patience in human illness. May your kind intercession offer healing for our sick brothers and sisters, comfort for all who suffer, courage for all who are afraid, hope for all who are afflicted, and trust that they have been chosen to be saints and are joined to Jesus in His suffering for the salvation of the world. Amen.



Noon Prayer

(Dating back to the 11th century, this prayer at noon invites the faithful to interrupt their work and raise their hearts and minds to God, to remember Mary's "yes" and to inspire us to say our own "yes" to God.)

V: The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary

R: And she conceived of the Holy Spirit.

Pope Francis' Prayer to Mary

who at the cross took part in Jesus' pain, keeping your faith firm.

The 3 o'clock Prayer

(At 3 o'clock on Good Friday, Jesus died for us and in an appearance to St. Faustina, He taught her to call upon His mercy at this hour "for at that moment, mercy was opened wide for every soul." (Diary 1572))

Instructions: Using the rosary, but instead of praying the Our Father & 10 Hail Mary's, pray the *Eternal Father* prayer and 10 *For the Sake* prayer.
