Faith Formation for Children

- Religious Education provides instruction in the Roman Catholic faith for children in grades K-8.
- Classes are held on Sundays
10:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m. (Mass)
11:00 a.m. - 12:15 p.m. (Class) at St. Anne of the Sunset School

Early Registration Fee:

Registration Until September 18th

- One Child - \$75
- Two or More children in same family - \$150

Late Registration Fee:

September 19th - October 2nd

- One Child - \$100
- Two or More children in same family - \$175

Confirmation Retreat Fee:

\$100 due by January 2023

- For children preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in May.

- No child will be turned away because of financial need. There are opportunities for parents to volunteer extra hours in lieu of full tuition.

Family Involvement

- The church holds that the parents are the primary educators of children in their faith development. We strive to assist and support your role by following the catechetical norms of the Archdiocese.
- The children participate in the Liturgy with their families at the 10:00 a.m. mass before class. Family Mass is every third Sunday of the month. During Family Mass, the children are active participants in the liturgy as lectors, ushers, flag bearers, and gift bearers.
- Adult Faith Formation is offered for parents while the children are learning in the classrooms.
