Faith Formation for Children

Our Religious Education program provides instruction in the Roman Catholic faith for children in grades K-8. At Saint Anne's our goal is to build the spiritual foundation of our students through doctrinal teachings and social involvement in the community

Classes are held on **Sundays** beginning with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass (**10:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.**) followed by classes (**11:15 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.**) at St. Anne of the Sunset School.

Early Registration Fee:

Registration Until September 1st

One Child - \$75/ Two or More children in same family - \$150

Late Registration Fee:

September 2nd - September 15th

One Child - \$100/Two or More children in same family - \$175

Confirmation Retreat Fee: \$100 due by April 2025 (Confirmation in May 2025)

No child will be turned away because of financial need. There are opportunities for parents to volunteer extra hours in lieu of full tuition.

Family Involvement

The Church holds that the parents are the primary educators of children in their faith formation. We strive to assist and support your role following the catechetical norms of the Archdiocese of San Francisco.



Children Participation

The children participate in the Liturgy with their families at the 10:00 a.m. Sunday Mass. Family Mass is every third Sunday of the month. During the Family Mass, the children are active participants in the liturgy as lectors, ushers and gift bearers. There are also various parish activities throughout the year for the children to take part in parish life. Specifically, during the Lenten Season (Soup Supper and Stations of the Cross) and Advent Season ('Gift Giving Tree').

Adult Faith Formation

Adult Faith Formation is offered for parents while the children are in the classrooms. These sessions are pointed towards the further deepening and understanding of Church teachings based on its Catechism. It is also designed to building a loving Christian community.

Curriculum

Doctrine - Morals -Worship

- Books and publications recommended and approved by the Office of Faith Formation of the Archdiocese of San Francisco,
- Emphasis on prayer, liturgy, social awareness, and moral truths of the Church.
- Corporal works of mercy such as monetary sacrifices for the Missionary Childhood Association, food banks and the Project Open Hand.
