





FEET ON THE GROUND

"Until next week, keep your feet on the ground and keep reaching for the stars!" Not today's scriptural wisdom, but legendary DJ Casey Kasem's sage advice, heard across America for generations, *American Top 40*'s challenging sign-off. Though Casey wasn't quoting scripture, today's Acts of the Apostles offers similar advice. As Jesus ascended, disciples "were looking intently at the sky." Wouldn't we prefer a soul-relaxing gaze into peaceful blue skies to a heart-breaking focus on this blood-stained earth? But heavenly questioners asked Jesus' first disciples, "Why are you standing there looking at the sky?" Earth awaited their mission! While our hearts should "keep reaching for" heaven, we need to "keep our feet on the ground." Ascension's scriptures and the Jubilee of Mercy remind us: the Jesus we revere as "ascended into heaven" lives right here among us on earth, awaiting our recognition and loving service.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The mystery of the Ascension has to do with holding in tension a sense of God's nearness, along with the burden caused by apparent signs of absence. The risen Jesus says to Mary Magdalene, "Do not cling to me," perhaps pointing out to her that his physical presence to the disciples was time-bound and temporary. It was a gift for their transformation, and after forty days, he vanished from their sight and hearing, though never out of their consciousness.

They do not mourn at his going this time: there is no trace of the disciples who hid in fear at his crucifixion, no sense of the women who wept softly as they carried ointments to the tomb through the dewy morning light. Instead, the scriptural accounts show them full of joy, comforted by his promise to be with them forever, and open to the Spirit's power. They are joyful, energized, aware, and united with one another in love. They seem to grasp an awareness that if the mission to the whole world was a serious one, then the presence of the Risen Christ could not be pinned down to any one place or time, but had to be always and everywhere completely available. All peoples, all times, all cultures were opened to receive him in this moment of the Ascension. The energy of this feast is drawn not from absence, but renewed and deeper presence.


Pastor's Column

Congratulations, Graduates! — This past week has been a fun week for our 40 Eighth Graders. After all their hard work and exams, they had their Dinner Dance on Tue., May 27, followed by the 8th Grade Picnic on Wed., May 28, and then the Baccalaureate Mass and lunch on Thurs., May 29. At that lunch, their 7th grade partner prophesized their future and who they would become. Then on Friday evening, May 31, they graduated from our school. They will be heading off to some of the best high schools in the City, and we're very proud of them. At the last SAPTO (Saint Anne Parents & Teachers' Organization) meeting, the "graduating" parents spoke of how grateful they were that their children attended our school. They were grateful not only for the academic excellence we offered to their children, but also for the values and character we helped instill in them and the wonderful sense of community we offered to them and their children.

To the principal, Mr. Thomas White, and the faculty and staff of St. Anne School, thank you for a job well done. Their combined efforts, along with the support of the parents, truly make St. Anne's a great school for our students. **Congratulations, Graduates and Parents!!!**

Missionary Cooperation Plan — Every year, the Archdiocese of San Francisco allows missionaries abroad to share their work and ministry with us and also to ask for our prayerful and financial support. This year, **Fr. Titus Kachinda from the Diocese of Singida, in Tanzania** will be speaking to us on Pentecost weekend (June 8 & 9). The 1st missionaries came to the region that is now the Diocese of Singida in 1908. From 0 Catholics in 1908, there are now over 178,000 Catholics, who make up 12.4% of the population. From being a mission territory, it became a Diocese in 1972 and from 1972 until the present it grew from 8 Parishes to 24, from 4 Priests to 70, and from 10 Religious sisters to 504. There are now 464 Catechists and 287 minor seminarians. The diocese also offers social services such as education, health care, and charitable care. They have 23 kindergarten schools, 8 primary schools, 7 secondary schools, 2 vocational training centers, 3 seminaries (2 minor and 1 preparatory seminary), 1 college for training teachers, and 1 catechetical training center. Also, there are 4 hospitals, 3 health centers, 9 dispensaries, 7 counseling centers, 1 nursing college, and 6 centers for serving the needy, the aged, and the disabled. The diocese has made available a water supply by installing windmills in several areas. As part of its 5-year Strategic Plan, it seeks to help its people increase food and cash incomes through better use of knowledge and skills. The **2nd collection on Pentecost Sunday, June 16, will support the excellent work being performed by the Diocese of Singida for her people in Tanzania.** I hope you'll join me in contributing to their wonderful work.
